ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Prepare food for the animals
- Clean acrylic, gravel vacuum and other general maintenance as required in exhibit
- Follow equipment disinfection procedures
- Feed animals and enclosures according to protocols, which may include live food sources.
- Maintain situational awareness in exhibits
- Attend all annual recurrent training programs
- Arrive on time for all scheduled shifts
- Adhere to the volunteer program attendance policy
- Promote Aquarium of the Bay's mission

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be able to commit to at least one shift a week on a standing schedule for at least six months
- Must be able to work with minimum supervision and be comfortable around various animals including reptiles, amphibians, mammals, and fish.
- Must be able to bend, lift to 25 pounds, walk up and down stairs, and be tolerant of a wet work environment.
