




EXHIBIT HIGHLIGHTS

River otters are considered a watershed ambassador as they are an indicator of a healthy water system; meaning if you see a river otter in the wild, you know that waterway is healthy.












EXHIBIT HIGHLIGHTS




OTTER TERRACE

Where are you located?

We are located next to world famous Pier 39 along the Embarcadero.

Our exact address is: The Embarcadero & Beach St., San Francisco, CA 94133

What kind of animals will I see?

There are over 24,000 animals at Aquarium of the Bay. This includes: North American river otters, giant sea bass, bat rays, sharks, our California state fish, the garibaldi and so much more throughout two floors of the building.

Where can I park?

There is a 5-story parking garage across the street from us at PIER 39. It costs \$10 per hour (weekdays), \$12 per hour (weekends and holidays). The garage is open 24/7. We do not validate parking.

Can I use my own caterer?

We have a list of preferred vendors that we work with that are sustainable businesses.

Can alcohol be served at Aquarium of the Bay events?

Alcohol is permitted but requires a licensed bartender to serve it. Inquire with our events team for assistance.

Do you provide A/V equipment?

We have a variety of A/V equipment including projectors, speakers, microphones, and more. Please speak with the events team to learn more about what kind of A/V equipment you need for the event.

What happens if I need to cancel?

- Cancelled less than 21 days prior to event is subject to a 50% cancellation fee.
- Cancelled less than 14 days prior to event is subject to a 75% cancellation fee.
- Cancelled less than 7 days prior to event is subject to a 100% cancellation fee

How do I book?

We require a 50% deposit to secure your event booking. The final payment and headcount are due one (1) month prior to the event.

How early can I set up?

You may arrive up to 2 hours early to set up prior to your event. Please arrange with the events team when you would like to come in.

What is the earliest time we can have an evening event?

The earliest time that an evening event can start is after 6:00 pm. Caterers and vendors are more than welcome to arrive earlier than that to start setting up.

Can I bring decorations for the event?

Yes, you may bring decorations for the event. The only rules that we have is that we do not allow single use plastics such as balloons. All decorations must be reusable items or come from biodegradable sources.

How late can events last?

The latest that guests can stay in the aquarium is until 12 AM (Midnight). Caterers and vendors may stay later if needed to clean up.




